#### **Before and After School**

# **Objects in Class**

Please do not send toys and other items from home to class. The children will not be able to play with them and they are distracting. Also, unfortunately some things do get stolen at school.

Your child may bring a water bottle. Please make sure the lid seals tightly. They will be leaving their water bottle in their backpack. We do not want it to spill on their folder or other things. There is a drinking fountain in the classroom that they may use, so they do not have to have a water bottle.
